

Kennel & Cattery Licence

All kennels and catteries have to be licensed by the local authority, which can inspect premises at any time. This inspection may be carried out by a vet, a dog warden or anyone appointed by the Environmental Health Department on their behalf. We have just had our inspection carried out and our licence renewed for a further 12 months. To pass our inspection we have to meet strict criteria concerning our facilities and the standard of care we provide, so naturally we are very pleased to have passed without any changes having to be made.

In the current very cold weather, the whole kennel building is heated and we can tell from using a max/min thermometer that the temperature stays within the right range. Extra heating is also provided in the cattery at the moment, in addition to the heat pads inside the igloo beds.



Frequently Asked Questions

Q:Why can't I leave my dog's own bedding?

A:Bedding tends to get dirty quickly in kennels because the dogs come in from exercise straight into their pens. We check each dog's bedding daily and change it frequently. We use Vetbed, the most hygienic and washable type of bedding we know. Washing a dog's own bedding would mean it no longer smelt of home. It would also make our laundry more difficult because of having to label everything and wash types of bedding which are bulkier and take longer to dry than Vetbed.

If you would like your dog to have something familiar with him/her, it is better to bring a toy.

Q: Can I pick up my pet after normal opening hours?

A: Only in exceptional circumstances and if pre-arranged before 5pm on the day of collection. Although there is always a responsible adult on these premises, we are not always available to serve late customers. If you are unable to contact us, we will always look after your dog or cat until the next day. We are open from 8am until 5pm every day of the year (except 25th and 26th December).
