FLEA ALERT!

Warmer summer weather offers perfect conditions for fleas, and we are seeing more dogs and cats coming in with them. We aim to keep our kennels and cattery a completely flea-free zone, so please ensure your pets have regular treatment to prevent fleas. If, like many people, you have difficulty finding a product which seems to work, please ask for advice at your veterinary surgery. You may need a prescription only product, or you may need to also treat the animal's environment (carpets, bedding etc) which is where the fleas spend most of their time. This will need a different product from the one used on the dog or cat.

Please also be very careful not to use dog flea treatments on cats.....some of them, especially those containing permethrin, can be deadly to cats.

We are now entering our busiest season, with school summer holidays about to start. Some dates are already fully booked, so to avoid disappointment, please book as far ahead as possible. We look forward to seeing you and your pets soon!
