Thank you to all our clients who helped with sponsorship, and well done Erica!



Microchipping

In 2016 the law will be changing so all dogs will have to be microchipped as a way of permanently identifying them. This enables lost dogs to be more quickly reunited with their owners. Cats can also be microchipped, although the new law only applies to dogs.

If your dog or cat is not yet microchipped, it can be done whilst they are boarding at Little Coombe by Jenny (a vet for over 30 years).

The microchip, about the size of a grain of rice, is inserted under the skin through a needle, similar to having an injection. The microchip has a unique number which is then registered to your pet and can be read by any vet practice, dog warden or dogs home.

The cost of microchipping is £15 +VAT including paperwork.
